Introduction

God’s heart for today

Jesus prayed that His kingdom would come on earth as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:10)

This is God’s priority, God’s purpose.

God desire to see His kingdom established in the mountains of society.

Isaiah 2:2 prophesied that "in the last days, the mountain of the LORD's temple will be established as the highest of the mountains; it will be exalted above the hills, and all nations will stream to it

Partnership with God

Chronicles 16:9 states that "the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is perfect toward Him"

God is actively seeking those whose hearts are perfect toward Him. God wants to partner with you amazingly.

He wants to manifest His glory and His transforming power through us.

Romans 8:19-20 states that all creation "awaits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God" because it was "subjected to futility" by God's will, but with the hope that it will one day be liberated.

The creation waits eagerly for the sons of God to arise and shine. The creation groans and travails in anticipation.

This is our season of arising and shining. If you believe that say a louder amen.

We are rising from obscurity to prominence.

"Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you"
(Isaiah 60:1)

In the beginning....

Genesis 1:26 states, "Then God said, 'Let us make humankind in our image, according to our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the wild animals of the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth'"

We know from Genesis that God's original purpose for man is to live in perpetual dominion. When I talk about dominion today, I mean exercising our redemptive right.

Our roles as MAGH

Essential requirements

What is required of us to succeed in the role?

1. Intimacy with God. (Genesis 39:1-3)

We must operate from the foundation of intimacy with the LORD.

This passage highlights the fact that intimacy with God is the starting point from which everything else flows.

The best gifts are those that flow from a profound relationship with God. Out of that kind of intimate relationship, you learn to prioritise matters with uncanny wisdom.

2. Favour and Authority.

We must carry Father's favour and authority.

*And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”
(Matthew 16:19)*
