

# Speaking Life Over Our Circumstances Like Abraham

Speaking life over our circumstances, like Abraham, requires faith-filled declarations based on God's promises. Here's how we can do it, with supporting scriptures:

## 1. Believe God's Promises Despite Circumstances

Abraham believed God's word even when reality seemed impossible.

**Romans 4:18-21 (NLT):**

*"Even when there was no reason for hope, Abraham kept hoping—believing that he would become the father of many nations. For God had said to him, 'That's how many descendants you will have!' And Abraham's faith did not weaken, even though, at about one hundred years of age, he figured his body was as good as dead—and so was*

*Sarah's womb. Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God. He was fully convinced that God is able to do whatever He promises."*

### **Supporting Scriptures:**

- **Hebrews 11:1 (NLT):** *"Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see."*
- **Numbers 23:19 (NLT):** *"God is not a man, so He does not lie. He is not human, so He does not change His mind. Has He ever spoken and failed to act? Has He ever promised and not carried it through?"*

### **Declaration:**

*"I trust in God's promises. Even if things look hopeless, I believe He is faithful to fulfill His word in my life."*

## 2. Speak What God Has Said, Not What You See

Abraham declared himself as the "father of many nations" before he had a son.

**Genesis 17:5 (NLT):**

*"What's more, I am changing your name. It will no longer be Abram. Instead, you will be called Abraham, for you will be the father of many nations."*

**Supporting Scriptures:**

- **Proverbs 18:21 (NLT):** *"The tongue can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences."*
- **Mark 11:23 (NLT):** *"I tell you the truth, you can say to this mountain, 'May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and it will happen. But you must really believe it will happen and have no doubt in your heart."*

### **Declaration:**

*"I will speak God's promises over my life, my family, and my future, knowing that His word does not return void."*

### **3. Align Your Words with Faith, Not Fear**

Abraham did not waver in faith; he gave glory to God.

### **Romans 4:20 (NLT):**

*"Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God."*

### **Supporting Scriptures:**

- **2 Corinthians 4:13 (NLT):** *"But we continue to preach because we have the same kind of faith the psalmist had when he said, 'I believed in God, so I spoke.'"*

- **Isaiah 55:11 (NLT):** *"It is the same with my word. I send it out, and it always produces fruit. It will accomplish all I want it to, and it will prosper everywhere I send it."*
- **Philippians 4:8 (NLT):** *"And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise."*

### **Declaration:**

*"I will not speak fear, doubt, or negativity. My words will reflect my faith in God's power and provision."*

**4. Thank God in Advance for the Answer**  
Before seeing the fulfillment, Abraham praised God.

## **Romans 4:20-21 (NLT):**

*"Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God. He was fully convinced that God is able to do whatever He promises."*

## **Supporting Scriptures:**

- **1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (NLT):** *"Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus."*
- **Philippians 4:6-7 (NLT):** *"Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all He has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus."*

## **Declaration:**

*"I thank You, Lord, that You are already working behind the scenes to bring my breakthrough."*

## **5. Be Fully Convinced That God is Able**

Abraham was fully convinced that God would do what He said.

**Romans 4:21 (NLT):**

*"He was fully convinced that God is able to do whatever He promises."*

**Supporting Scriptures:**

- **Ephesians 3:20 (NLT):** *"Now all glory to God, who is able, through His mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think."*
- **Jeremiah 32:27 (NLT):** *"I am the LORD, the God of all the peoples of the world. Is anything too hard for me?"*
- **Luke 1:37 (NLT):** *"For nothing is impossible with God."*

## Declaration:

*"I am confident that God is able to do exceedingly and abundantly above all I ask or imagine."*

## Practical Application for the Week

- **Morning:** Speak these declarations over yourself and your situation.
- **Throughout the Day:** Replace negative thoughts with faith-filled words.
- **Night:** Thank God for what He is doing, even before you see it.

By applying these principles, we will see the power of God's promises manifest in our lives, just as Abraham did!
